Side dishes - (Ricearoni, Hamburger Helper)

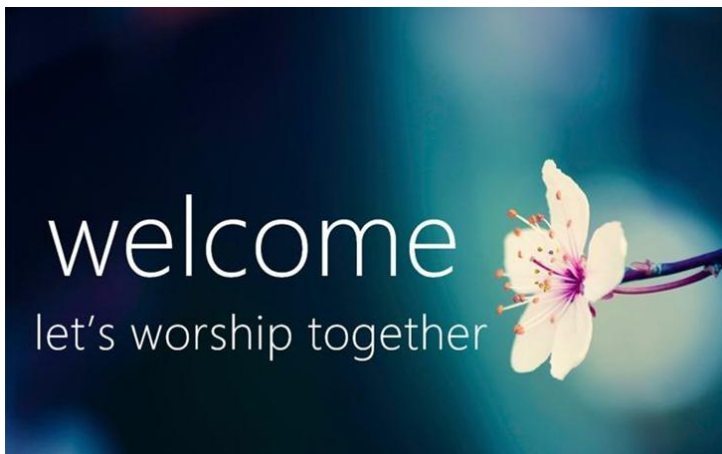

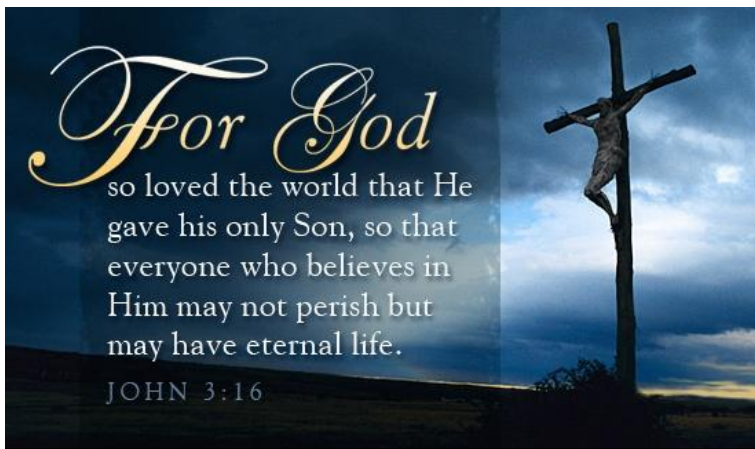
